Awards for A (Warm up), ECh All Around, Type & Conf. & ECh Mono Qualifier Competitions, after the Competition. Ribbons 1.-6. Place Prize Giving Ceremony for the open Lower Austrian Championship & Austrian National Championship Jumping, after the Prize Giving of the international Competition. Sash 1.u.2. Place, Medals 1.-3. Place, Ribbons 1.-6. Place.

All Competitors of the European Championship Sports Arabians will have a free Catalogue and a memory plate per horse.

RULES & REGULATIONS

International Riding -& Driving Event. Open for all horses registered at birth in a WAHO accepted European Studbook of a ECAHO member. All other WAHO accepted and registered horses have to be registered in an ECAHO European Studbook until 1. January 2008.

FEI (Féderation Équestre International) <u>www.horsesport.org</u> & ÖTO (Österreichische Turnierordnung). <u>www.fena.at</u>, ECAHO rules <u>www.ecaho,org</u> Exact Time schedule in the evening the day before. Starting list one hour before the competition at the show office. Results at the show office. Cancellation, merging of classes as well as changing of order and place are at the discretion of the organizer.

All participating horses need to have liability insurance and need to be free of any contagious deseas. Vaccination Certificate (according to the FEI

Veterinary Regulation 1.06.2006), national registration as competition horse, horse passport and valid national riders licence have to be presented at the show office.

For all Driving Competitions Vehicles and Harness for Single horse following FEI & USEF rules are allowed.

Pleasure Driving no Groom only Header. Pleasure Driving Cart, Formal Driving Buggy or Dressage coach.

In the Mono Qualifiers the best ten horses are qualified for the Finals. (Dressage, Jumping, Classic Pleasure, Reining, Trail, Western Pleasure, Traditional Arabian Riding Class).

Cross EM Mono only one go round, Comp. 39 a (FEI Rule) exceeded Cross from ECh All Around Compet.39.

The Pleasure Competitions will be split in two groups if there are more than 20 horses nominated. The five best of each group are qualified for the Finals. The two official Starting numbers have to be fixed on both sides of the saddle blanket, both sides of the Driving Vehicle in the original size and in that way that they are always visible. Others than the original numbers are not accepted and the doorman will not allow to enter the arena. For Cross Country and Cross Driving these numbers have to be shown on the front and on the back of the Rider/Driver. No Numbers on the Bridle of the horse!

QUALIFICATION

Every ECAHO A-Level Event or official open Event in the same difficulty will be accepted as Qualification. The qualification can be from this year or the last two years ago together with the nominated horses or separately horse and rider. This Qualification has to be send together with the Entry Form. The Qualification for Cross Country and Cross Driving has to be done minimum one week ago.

All Around Classic the Qualification has to be done in Dressage or in Show Jumping.

All Around Western the Qualification has to be done in Reining or Trail.

All Around Driving the Qualification is Dressage Driving.

The positive Result in these Competitions has to be recorded by the FN or the Organizer of the official Event.

All Qualification can be done at the Level A Competitions at the show.

Not possible in Cross Country and Cross Country Driving (FEI rule only one Competition on a weekend).

Type & Conformation is obligatory for all All Around European Championships. The Rider/Driver has to present his horse in competition outfit with Competition Bridle or in a show halter. The eligible Competitions will be added to the obligatory.

Classic are allowed three Competitions per day, Western six Competitions per day. Type & Conformation is not counting, Pole Bending in Classic ½. European Champion will be the horse.

One Rider/Driver is allowed to start three different horse. Same Rider/Driver per horse.

The European Champion is that horse who collects the most points with the same Rider/Driver.

If two horses ends up with the same points, that horse with the higher points in Type & Conformation will be the Champion.

If there is an European Champion horse (1, 2., 3. placed) not present at the Final Prize Giving Ceremony, it will be disqualified and the title will go to the next placed horse.

All horses are able to compete at all Level A (Warm up) All Around, Mono Competitions and Championships.

Competitions where horses from different Categories take part (Classic, Western, Driving) are judged together, will have a winner with award but the ranking list for adding the points to the All Around ranking list will be divided according to the categories and points allocated.
